

M-25 Bridge Improvements

**Fort Gratiot, St. Clair County
2018**

What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will complete preventive maintenance on M-25 over the Howe Drain in May. This work will address unsatisfactory elements of the bridge, including the structural integrity of the bridge beams.

The work will result in a new wearing surface over the bridge, new concrete barrier railing, protection against scour, and serve to extend the life of the existing structure.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

This work will require a full detour of the roadway during parts of construction. MDOT anticipates the full detour will be needed for approximately three weeks while crews address work on the bridge beams. During this time, M-25 traffic will be detoured on Keewahdin Road and M-136 (Pine Grove Avenue).

Public meetings will be announced ahead of the project to allow residents and business owners an opportunity to address questions and concerns.
